The **HOPE Leadership Institute (HLI)** is the first and only statewide leadership program specifically designed for professional Latinas in California. The goal of the Institute is to train Latinas in vital advocacy skills, enabling them to create fundamental change within their communities.

The **HLI has created a pipeline of over 500 Latina leaders** who are committed to improving political and economic parity for all communities. Alumnae represent diverse professional sectors and all major regions of California, many of whom serve in public office or on statewide boards and commissions.

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PROGRAM SESSIONS*

SESSION I
JAN 24-26
SACRAMENTO

Campaign Boot Camp is an intensive training providing interaction with high-level consultants, elected officials, and Sacramento leadership.

SESSION II
MARCH 7-9
LOS ANGELES

Latina History Day unites hundreds of women to celebrate the political and cultural achievements of our community. This session introduces the Latina Agenda: healthcare, education, and economic empowerment.

SESSION III
MAY 21-23
SACRAMENTO

Latina Action Day Sacramento provides an opportunity for participants to use their research, analysis, and advocacy skills to engage State representatives in meaningful dialogue.

SESSION IV
JULY 17-20
LA/BAKERSFIELD

The **Central Valley Session** explores regional issues like water and agriculture by combining the perspectives of academics, community leaders, and industry experts. Through these varying views, participants are challenged to evaluate their own leadership style, effectiveness, and legacy.

SESSION V
SEPT/OCT
WASHINGTON, DC

Latina Action Day - DC marks the culmination of HLI with a powerful advocacy session, bringing together Latinas to impact public policy and further their effectiveness as leaders.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be a recognized community leader with at least 5 years of leadership experience**
- Be a mid or high level professional ready for the next step in your career
- Must reside in California

**Average participant age is 35+

COMMITMENTS

- Must attend all 5 sessions
- **Complete individual and group projects outside of session**
- Expected to advocate on behalf of Latinas
- Dedicated to HOPE's mission
- Contribute to the Friends of HOPE Donor Network

COST

HLI is tuition-free, however, throughout the nine month program participants will incur an estimated cost of \$1,000 (application fee, travel, lodging for Session IV, educational materials, etc). Limited income-based travel scholarships are available.
